



IMPORTANT REMINDERS



NO RIDE ZONES. We'll have plenty of places to ride, and a few limited spots where we'll need to park our Onewheels and actually use our feet. This includes the main lawn in front of the lodge and main stage, and the area between the main stage and the Art Barn. Please respect these areas to prevent damage.



Fire Safety is absolutely critical. You are free to Cook, Grill, BBQ at your site with self-contained electric or gas grills and stoves. No campfires are allowed at your campsite or anywhere at Camp Navarro with the exception of the main campfire ring located near the main stage.



There are **NO PETS** allowed on the property. Please contact us if you have any questions.



Electric rideables are welcome, but Camp Seek N Shred isn't the place for dirt bikes or anything else that could tear up the forest. Please be respectful.



How to Unload? We'll have handcarts available in Lot 1 for those in Teepees and Lower Cabins. For those in Upper Cabins, Adirondacks or camping in or near those villages, find your spot after registration and park temporarily while you unload. Once done, park in Lot 2. For those with Truck/Van/Car camping passes, follow signs to The Deep End.



Camping **IN** or **ON** your vehicle? Make sure you have a Truck/Van/Car Camping Pass. You'll enter at Gate 2 and stop by the Corral for Registration. From there, follow signs to The Deep End and our crew will help with placement. **PRO-TIP:** You may pass under some overhead lighting, have a friend spot you if you're in a taller vehicle.



Want to camp near a friend? Tents can be set up in any of the villages but please note no cars or vehicles are allowed in the cabin villages. Truck/Van/Car camping will be in The Deep End located down near the Redwood River Grove.



Bring headphones or we'll have a limited amount available for Silent Disco. Groove with your friends in unison by the campfire or while checking out the Corral Terrain Park.
