




TEEPEES, CABINS, & ADIRONDACK CABINS



Have your Eventbrite tickets handy as you arrive to Gate 1. Those with Teepees and Lower Cabins will be directed to enter Lot 1 to park and then head to registration located by the Corral. Those with reservations for Upper Cabins and Adirondacks will be directed to Gate 2, enter and park by the Corral and then visit registration.



BRING YOUR OWN BEDDING. Teepees, Cabins, and Adirondacks have mattresses but you are responsible for your own bedding. Plan accordingly for sheets, pillows, sleeping bags, or security blankets you may need to be comfortable. If you're flying in, we may have some bedding available, please reach out.



Deluxe Teepees are located near the RV Grove and Lower Cabins. Each has one (1) queen bed & one (1) additional twin camp mattress on platforms. These units also include a rug, lantern, and nightstand. Bring your own bedding.




Upper Cabins (Apache, Hopi, Mohawk, Delaware) - Each Cabin Sleeps 3-4, include 1 Queen + 2 Singles. Cabins include power, lights, heaters. Bring your own bedding.



Lower Cabins (Sonoma, Ukiah, Santa Rosa II, Windsor) - Each Cabin sleeps 8-9, include 3 bunk beds with singles (6) + 1 bunk with single on top/double on bottom. Cabins include power, lights, heaters. Bring your own bedding.



Adirondack Cabins, located in Pawnee and Cherokee villages. Each Adirondack Cabin Sleeps 4-5, Include 1 Queen + 3 Singles. No power, 3-sided cabins with privacy curtain on one side. Bring your own bedding.



Lower and Upper Cabins have electricity, Teepees and Adirondacks do not. Please make use of charging areas in the Redwood Cathedral, Flux Mvmnt Camp, and the Art Barn to help reduce strain on the power at cabins as we want to avoid overloading circuits.



Please be respectful and keep your lodging clean of any mud or debris from the outside.
