




# ARRIVAL INFO



Pro Tip: Enter directions into your GPS/Phone while you still have service. Expect to lose signal as you get closer to the venue. After you turn onto Masonite-Industrial Rd, it will be approximately 0.7 miles to Camp Navarro.




Have your Eventbrite tickets handy as you arrive to Gate 1. Teepees, RVs, or Lower Cabins will be directed towards Lot 1 to park and then head to registration. All other tent camping, car camping, Upper Cabins or Adirondacks will be directed to Gate 2 and then registration.



Camping will be spread amongst the expansive property. Tent camping can be set up within the villages or other open areas. Van/Truck/Car Camping will be primarily located near parking lot 3 and the Redwood River Grove. Tent, Teepee, Cabin, and Adirondack Cabin dwellers will unload their vehicles near their lodging location and then park in a designated lot.



Camp SeeknShred is family friendly and we love seeing young ones get a chance to explore this amazing spot. Please be respectful of your neighbors when it comes to loud noises, amplified music, and extracurricular activities.



Onsite power in various locations such as the Lodge, Art Barn, and the Cabin villages. Adirondack Cabins and Teepees do not have electricity. Charging available in the Santa Cruz Wheelslip area at the Redwood Cathedral and at Flux Mvmnt in the Crow village. Feel free to bring your own power source.



Fire Safety is absolutely critical. You are free to Cook, Grill, BBQ at your site with self-contained electric, gas, or charcoal grills and stoves. No campfires are allowed at your campsite or anywhere at Camp Navarro with the exception of the main campfire ring located near the main stage.



There is no cell phone reception on the property. iMessaging, texting, and calling over Wi-Fi may work, but is not guaranteed on all devices. We have a landline on the property that can be used in case of emergency only. Please enjoy the opportunity to unplug!



There is a robust Wi-Fi system available throughout most of the property. As always, this can be subject to downtime or limited bandwidth during the course of the event.



Please bring refillable water containers. All water from faucets at Camp Navarro is potable, along with a fountain and water filling station outside of the Meadow Café. There are two shower buildings, numerous outdoor showers, and bathrooms throughout the property and in the lodge.



Food? Cook your own OR purchase a meal plan from Camp Navarro in advance. Plan in advance as there will not be any a la carte food options available and meal plans will not be available on site. We will have coffee and pastries available for the mornings. You can cook, grill, use a stove at your campsite.
