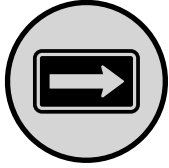




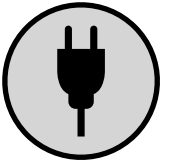
RV/TRAILER INFO



RVs/Trailers will be parked in the RV Grove and Lot 1. Depending on vehicle size and arrival time you may be parked in either location. Show your RV Pass ticket to security at Gate 1 upon arrival and then follow instructions from the parking crew. Park your rig, visit registration to check in, then return to finish setting up camp.



Please plan to fill your fresh water tanks **before** entering the venue. There is potable water on site but you'll want to have your fresh tank full for arrival. There are no sewer hookups on site, but there is a dump station at the Mendocino County Fairgrounds on your way back through Boonville, about 20 min from the venue.



Limited power hookups are available in the RV Grove, and we can not guarantee power for all RVs. Share available power with your neighbors and come prepared with anything you may need to power your rig.



Fire Safety is Critical! No fires are allowed at your campsite or anywhere at Camp Navarro with the exception of the main campfire circle located near the stage.



Want to camp near another friend with an RV or Trailer? Arrive together for the best chance of being in close proximity. We'll do our best but will be limited based on available space.



Can your tent-camping friends join you near your RV? Sure! Just be mindful of your neighbors.



Tow vehicles for trailers will need to be disconnected and moved out of the RV area once you've parked your trailer.
